EU and UK Sanctions related to Iron and Steel Products from Russia & Belarus

In response to the Russian attack on Ukraine, the EU has adopted comprehensive economic and financial sanctions against Russia. These sanctions are based on the already existing embargo regimes of Regulation (EU) 833/2014 (Russia Embargo Regulation) and Regulation (EU) 269/2014 (Ukraine Territorial Integrity measures).

With the Council Regulation (EU) 2023/1214 of 23rd June, 2023, the EU tightened restrictions on Imports of Iron and Steel goods by requiring Importers of sanctioned Iron and Steel goods that have been processed in a third country to prove that the Imports used do not come from Russia. These tightened restrictions took effect on the 30th September, 2023.

Having performed all necessary due diligence with Harwin plc's supply chain, we declare that the products sold by Harwin plc do not contain any Iron or Steel originating and having been exported from Russia. Likewise, they do not incorporate any Iron or Steel components that have been processed in a third country, that contain Iron or Steel originating from Russia.
